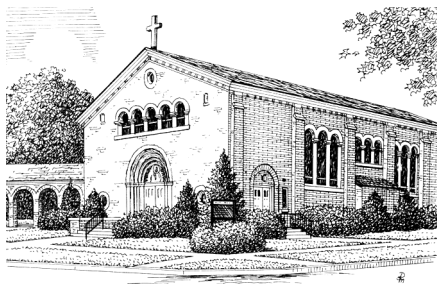

A "Rorate Coeli" Mass is a special Mass at dawn in honor of Our Lady during Advent, held entirely in candlelight. She, of course, is one of the "stars" of the Advent/Christmas season!

"Rorate Coeli" is Latin and comes from the Introit of the Mass and means "Drop down dew, ye Heavens, from above..." from Isaiah 45:8, prophesying the coming of the Savior.

The Mass will be a Traditional Sung Mass in Latin. It is a beautiful Mass that takes place as the sun is rising, reminding us that Jesus "dawned" on our world that first Advent coming to our rescue as Savior.






