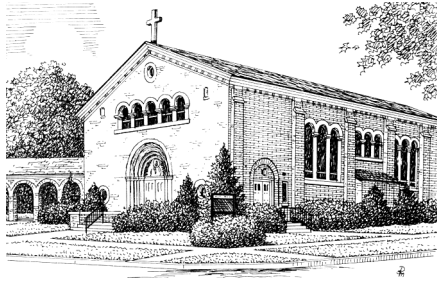

**A FEW GOOD MEN** Altar Boy training will take place Saturday, March 4th. Boys from 4th grade through High School may apply. The time will be announced in next week's bulletin. But not every boy is qualified. Read the following and consider if you are the kind of young man who can serve at the Altar of God.

**What is a server?** As a server you assist the priest, who is the celebrant of Holy Mass and other liturgies. Servers help make Catholic worship reverent, efficient, and beautiful. Servers are very important to Catholic worship, and server training is designed to help you be good and confident in that duty. At the altar, your service is directed firstly to God, secondly, as help to the priests, acolytes and other servers, and thirdly, as an assistance to the faithful who have come to worship God. Your actions are visible, but you are never a performer. By your faithful duty, you remain always a servant of Jesus Christ and his Church.

The practiced server is a member of a team, working in harmony with others, serving for the glory of God, seeing work at the altar as prayer in action. A good server is a faithful, noble, prayerful and sincere young man. The good server is careful, reverent and well-groomed. He serves when scheduled, and finds a substitute when he cannot come as scheduled. 
