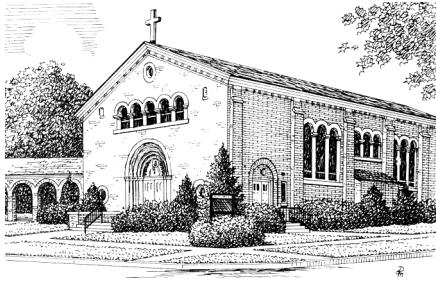

Lenten Food Drive for Kids

The Sacred Heart Knights of Columbus are again sponsoring a Lenten food drive from March 5—April 2 with a special opportunity for children to participate.

Kids are encouraged to pick up a sticker-sheet after Mass today in the back of church. Starting next weekend, kids who bring at least one non-perishable food item with them to Mass will receive a sticker to put on their sheet. On Palm Sunday, bring a final food item and the sticker sheet and receive a prize courtesy of the Knights! Adults are encouraged to bring food items as well.

Items especially in need at the Catholic Social Services Food Market: peanut butter, canned soup, canned fruit, canned vegetables, canned stew, canned fish, canned beans, pasta & sauce, ramen, rice (most prefer brown). Other nonperishable food items welcome as well.

What does non-perishable mean? Any food that is "shelf stable"—you can keep it in your pantry and it won't go bad. Bring only food that has not reached its "sell by" date.

For victims of abuse—We pray for those who have suffered harm from members of the Church; may they find within the Church herself a concrete response to their pain and suffering.




