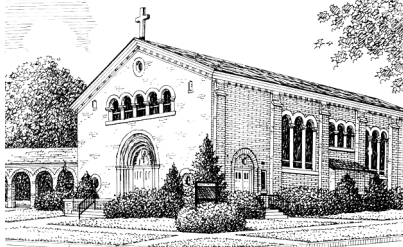

As you may know, historic school choice legislation (LB753, the **Opportunity Scholarships Act**) was signed into law. Nebraska was the last state in the country to pass a school choice bill, and some states have been implementing school choice programs for over 30 years. LB753 was supported by a super-majority of Senators from across Nebraska on both sides of the political aisle, and advocated for by the Nebraska Catholic Conference. This law will be life-changing for thousands of Nebraska children in need of better educational opportunities.

Unfortunately, there is already an effort to repeal this law, and your help is needed to make sure Nebraska parents—especially low-income parents—can choose the best education for their child. Please consider doing these few things to help protect parental rights and education choice:

1. “Decline to Sign” the so-called “Support Our Schools” petition being circulated across the state, and please urge your family and friends to similarly “Decline to Sign.”
2. Sign up to volunteer for the Keep Kids First campaign to protect the Opportunity Scholarships Act at www.KeepKidsFirstNebraska.com.
