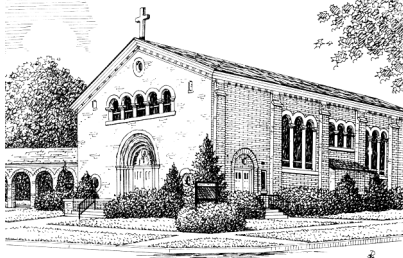

The Eucharistic Revival Pilgrim Passport is a way to deepen our understanding, love, and appreciation for the great gift and mystery of the Holy Eucharist while enjoying a traveling adventure to different locations.

The Eucharistic Passport will be **available in the church on the altar railing near the handicap door.** You may pick up an official Eucharistic passport indicating the locations of the 17 specially designated

Eucharistic sites across the diocese. At these locations, at designated times, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for silent prayer and adoration in a monstrance on the altar.

Once you have completed your holy hour, there will be an official stamp located at the back of the church or chapel. We ask you to stamp your passport and to write in the date of your visit to show that you've visited the site. You will have approximately 12 months to fill up all 17 spaces on your passport, if you wish. Our Eucharistic Passport Pilgrimage will conclude July 17, 2024. You might call this a holy competition of prayer, but there will be prizes and special recognition given to the first 10 people who complete the entire pilgrimage before July 17 of next year.
